



Terms and Condition of Entry to Responsible Gambling Awareness Week Creative Design Competition

1. Entry instructions and prize information form part of these Terms and Conditions. By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
2. The promotion is open to young people aged between 16 and 25 years of age at time of submission of entry who reside in the Greater Shepparton Local Government Area. Proof of age or residence must be supplied if requested.
3. Participants may enter the competition one time only. As entries will not be returned, participants are encouraged to keep a copy of their entry.
4. Competition commences 15/03/10 and entries must be received by 5pm on 23/04/10. Entries submitted after this time will not be eligible for entry in this competition and will be disregarded.
5. Entries are to be submitted to Gambler's Help Team at Goulburn Valley Community Health Service in person: 399 Wyndham Street Shepparton, or via mail: PO Box 1167 Shepparton Vic 3632, or e-mail: ghteam@gvchs.com.au.
6. Entries must be original, not in the public domain, factually accurate, and must not infringe or violate any law or the legal or equitable right of any person or entity, nor contain material that infringes or violates any personal property rights of others or that constitutes defamation, invasion of privacy, an infringement of the intellectual property rights of any third person, or is otherwise unlawful.
7. All entries and all rights to their publication become the property of the Gambler's Help Program from Goulburn Valley Community Health Service upon submission, which may use, edit and excerpt these entries for promotional or any other purpose, including placing them online or publishing without attribution or compensation, additional or otherwise.
8. A Short List of Five Entrants from which the Competition Winners will be selected will be selected on Wednesday the 28th of April. Short List participants will be notified by phone and be invited to attend an event on Friday 14th May at which time the competition winners will be announced and the winning entries will be available for viewing. Winners may be required for media liaison, including interviews and photo opportunities.
9. If the winning entrants are under the age of 18 years consent will be required from a parent/guardian for the use of the entry for advertising or promotional purposes.
10. Entries will be judged by a representative from Gambler's Help Goulburn Valley Community Health Service, a representative from Word and Mouth and a local media representative. Judging criteria will be based around "Creativity and Originality", "How Well the Responsible Gambling Message was demonstrated" and "Presentation". Each criterion will be out of 10 with a total possible score of 30.
11. Prizes Pool (to be awarded in the form of a voucher from a store of the winner's choosing): \$500 for the first-prize, \$250 for the second-prize, \$150 for the third prize and an additional two entries with receive \$50 each for honourable mention. Total prize pool is valued at \$1,000.
12. Winning entries will be displayed at Goulburn Valley Community Health Service and may be published at the discretion of Goulburn Valley Community Health Service.
13. Judging panel's decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
